





RACKLEY MURDER CASE



ALEX RACKLEY

 was a member of the New York chapter of the Black Panther Party in the late 1960s. In May 1969, Rackley, 19, was suspected by other Panthers of being a police informant. He was brought to Panther headquarters in New Haven, held captive and tortured there for 4 days, "tried" in kangaroo court, condemned to death, taken to the wetlands of Middlefield, and murdered.



(NX1) NEW HAVEN, Conn., Aug. 31-PANTHER CONVICTED-Black Panther Lennie McLucas, above, was convicted Monday on a charge of conspiracy to murder in connection with the May 1969 death of fellow Panther Alex Rackley. He was acquitted of three other charges by a jury of two blacks and 10 whites, and was taken back to the Litchfield State Correctional Center.


GEORGE SAMS

 Sams turned state's evidence in return for a reduced charge of second-degree murder. He testified that, acting under direct orders from national party leader Bobby Seale, he arranged for the kidnapping of Rackley to Panther headquarters in New Haven, where Rackley was tortured for two days then transported to the marshlands of Middlefield, Connecticut, where he was shot by Warren Kimbro and Lonnie McLucas on Sams' orders.

KIDNAPPING

• On February 4, 1974, Patty Hearst, the 19-yearold daughter of newspaper publisher Randolph Hearst, is kidnapped from her apartment in Berkeley, California, by two black men and a white woman, all three of whom are armed. Her fiance, Stephen Weed, was beaten and tied up along with a neighbor who tried to help. Witnesses reported seeing a struggling Hearst being carried away blindfolded, and she was put in the trunk of a car. Neighbors who came out into the street were forced to take cover after the kidnappers fired their guns to cover their escape

JIMMY HOFFA



HOFEX – jimmy hoffa

- His disappearance 40 years ago is one of the greatest unsolved mysteries in U.S. history, and now new evidence has emerged about Jimmy Hoffa's possible fate.
- A mobster who was believed to be involved in the labor boss's disappearance suggested before he died last year that the feds were on the right track when they searched a New Jersey dump for Hoffa's remains, a bombshell report says.
- Investigative reporter Dan Moldea confirmed that the FBI searched the dump in 1975, looking for a 55-gallon drum they believed the Teamsters boss had been entombed in.

RESMURS

- On June 26, 1975, Special Agents Jack R. Coler and Ronald A. Williams were killed while attempting to serve arrest warrants for robbery and assault with a dangerous weapon on the Oglala Sioux Indian Reservation in Pine Ridge, South Dakota. Four people were indicted for the murders of SAs Williams and Coler.
- The fifth person indicted for these murders, Leonard Peltier, was convicted and received two consecutive life sentences. June 26, 1975

FCI-FORT HUACHUCA

 Welcome to Fort Huachuca, home of the U.S. Army Intelligence Center and the U.S. Army **Network Enterprise Technology Command** (NETCOM)/9th Army Signal Command. Located in Cochise County, in southeast Arizona, about 15 miles north of the border with Mexico, Fort Huachuca was annexed in 1971 by the city of Sierra Vista and was declared a national landmark in 1976.

LEESA JO SHANNER CASE

 A federal jury in the US last month convicted William Floyd Zamastil, of Wisconsin, of the 1973 murder, rape and kidnap of Leesa Jo Shaner, 22. Ms Shaner's remains were found in a shallow grave in Arizona. Witnesses testified and evidence was presented at Zamastil's trial that he abducted her from Tucson airport and took her to Ft Huachuca where he raped, murdered and buried her.

 SACRAMENTO — A mysterious serial bomber linked to 15 attacks that have left two people dead and 22 injured since 1978 apparently struck again Monday, killing a lobbyist with a pipe bomb concealed in an innocuous-looking package mailed to his office. Richard Ross, Sacramento's FBI special agent in charge, said a "preliminary assessment of some of the materials" at the scene of the bombing just four blocks from the state Capitol "strongly indicates" it was the work of the serial attacker known as Unabomber.



THE UNABOMBER

- How do you catch a twisted genius who aspires to be the perfect, anonymous killer—who builds untraceable bombs and delivers them to random targets, who leaves false clues to throw off authorities, who lives like a recluse in the mountains of Montana and tells no one of his secret crimes?
- That was the challenge facing the FBI and its investigative partners, who spent nearly two decades hunting down this ultimate lone wolf bomber.

NIGHT STALKER

 The Original Night Stalker is a media epithet for an unidentified serial killer and rapist who committed 50 rapes in Northern California during the mid-1970s and murdered twelve people in Southern California from 1979 through 1986.[2] Other monikers include the East Area Rapist, the Diamond Knot Killer, and since 2013, he has also been referred to as the **Golden State Killer**.[3]



HARVEY'S BOMBING

 The Harvey's Resort Hotel bombing took place on August 26–27, 1980, when three men planted an elaborately booby trapped bomb containing 1,000 pounds (450 kg) of dynamite at Harvey's Resort Hotel (now "Harveys") in Stateline, Nevada, United States. The mastermind behind the bomb, former millionaire John Birges, was attempting to extort \$3 million (\$8.7 million today) from the casino, claiming he had lost \$750,000 (\$2.2 million today) gambling there.

JOHN BIRGES - BOMBER

John Birges, Sr., was a Hungarian immigrant from Clovis,
California. He flew for the German Luftwaffe during World
War II. He was captured and sentenced to 25 years of hard
labor in a Russian gulag. Eight years into his sentence in the
gulag, he was released during a period of mass repatriation
of Soviet Union POWs to their home countries, and
returned to Hungary. From there, he emigrated to the U.S.
and built a successful landscaping business, but his
addiction to gambling led to his losing a large amount of
money and prompted the bomb plot.[5]

SIHK TERRORIST

• The **Khalistan movement** is a <u>Sikh nationalist</u> movement, which seeks to create a separate country called **Khalistān** (Punjabi: ਖਾਲਿਸਤਾਨ, "The Land of the Pure") in the Punjab region of South Asia.



DIDAR SINGH BAINS



BAINES

 Didar Singh Bains is of the best-known Punjabi Americans in Yuba City and globally. Despite his humble origins, Bains emerged in the postwar period as the largest peach farmer in California and one of the largest in the world. He is widely known as the "Peach King" due to his success in farming. Mr. Bains has played critical roles in founding Sikh institutions and festivals in Yuba City and globally. He wields political influence in California, Washington, D.C. and in India,

INDIRA GHANDI

 Indira Gandhi, the 3rd Prime Minister of India, was assassinated at 9:20 a.m. on 31 October 1984, at her Safdarjung Road, New Delhi residence.[1][2] She was killed by two of her bodyguards,[3] Satwant Singh and Beant Singh, in the aftermath of Operation Blue Star, the Indian Army's June 1984 assault on the Golden Temple in Amritsar which left the Sikh temple heavily damaged.[4]

CODDINGTON MURDER CASE

 On May 16, 1987, two teenaged models and their elderly female chaperones were reported missing after they failed to return from a trip to Lake Tahoe, on the California-Nevada border, for production of an anti-drug video program.

•

 A three-day search by fifty law enforcement officers, including agents of the FBI, centered on Lake Tahoe, where local girls had complained of a "weird" man who tried to recruit them for antidrug video projects.

- SOUTH LAKE TAHOE, Calif., May 19— Federal agents smashed through the door of a mobile home Monday to rescue two terrified adolescent models and arrest a man who the authorities believe kidnapped them and killed their chaperones.
- Herbert James Coddington, 28 years old, lured the girls on the pretext of filming an anti-drug film. He was arrested late Monday and booked for investigation of murder and kidnapping.
